The petition having been filed on 20.01.2025 and having stood over for consideration to this day, the Commission passed the following interim order:

INTERIM ORDER

The Transmission Corporation of Telangana Limited (TGTRANSCO) (petitioner) has filed the above-named petition under section 61, 62 and 64 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Act 2003) read with section 26 (5) of the Telangana Electricity Reform Act, 1998 (Reform Act) seeking determination of aggregate revenue requirement and filing for proposed tariff in respect of transmission business for FY 2025 – 2026 under MYT framework provided in Regulation No. 2 of 2023.

2. The petitioner have sought the following prayer in the petition:

- a) to take the accompanying Annual tariff petition for filing aggregate revenue requirement and revised transmission tariff and charges for the FY 2025 – 26 of 5th control period that is FY 2024-25 to FY: 2028-29 for transmission business by TGTRANSCO on record.

- b) The Hon'ble TGERC for kind consideration of income tax paid for the FY: 2022-23, in line with previous APR Orders, and adjust the true-up accordingly in ensuing ATP orders for 5th control period, as prayed for in the Review Petition to O. P. No. 02 of 2024.
- c) To grant suitable opportunity to TGTRANSCO within a reasonable time frame to file additional material information, if required;
- d) To grant the waivers prayed for with respect to such filing requirements as TGTRANSCO is unable to comply with at this stage, as more specifically detailed and for the reasons set out in the present ARR, FPT for Annual tariff petition filing;.
- e) To treat the filing as complete in view of substantial compliance as also the specific requests for waivers with justification placed on record;
- f) To consider and approve TGTRANSCO's ARR, FPT for annual tariff petition including all requested regulatory treatments in the filing;
- g) To pass such order, as the Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

3. The Commission has notified the Multi Year Tariff Regulation in Regulation No. 2 of 2023 providing for determination of tariff in respect of generation, transmission, SLDC activity, wheeling and retail supply. Accordingly, TGTRANSCO has filed revised ARR and tariff proposals which was taken on record by the Commission in the above said O. P. The said petition has been taken up for consideration and the public consultation process including hearing had been undertaken vide public notice dated 04.02.2025 and that public hearing was also completed on 11.03.2025. The order in the above mentioned petition is required to be passed on or before 31.03.2025, which will come into affect from 01.04.2025.

4. As the Commission was in the process of passing the order in the above said OP, model code of conduct in respect of biennial election to the Telangana Legislative Council from Hyderabad local authorities' constituency, came into force with effect from 24.03.2025 on account of issuance of schedule by Election Commission of India (ECI).

5. However, in view of the imposition of model code of conduct on account of election to the Telangana Legislative Council, the Commission is unable to pass the

orders on or before 31.03.2025. The Commission has addressed a letter dated 27.03.2025 to Election Commission of India through the state screening committee seeking permission of Election Commission of India to permit the Commission to pass the order in the above said petition.

6. The transmission tariff as determined for FY 2024 - 2025 as part of 5th control period FY 2024 – FY 2025 to FY 2028 – FY 2029 will cease to be effective after 31.03.2025. In order to avoid vacuum of transmission tariff, there is a necessary to extend the subsisting tariff for transmission activity to be levied and collected by the TGTRANSCO in the state of Telangana, from 01.04.2025 until the orders are passed after receiving permission of the ECI or cessation of model code of conduct whichever is earlier.

7. Keeping in view the above situation, the Commission in exercise of powers conferred under section 94 (2) of the Act, 2003 read with section 28 of the Telangana Electricity Reform Act, 1998, hereby passes interim order extending the tariff for transmission activity as determined by order dated 28.10.2024 in O. P. No. 14 of 2024 to be applicable from 01.04.2025.

8. The above extension will be in force from 01.04.2025 till a fresh order is passed by the Commission.
