MEMORADAM OF APPEAL BEFORE THE HON'BLE AP ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION FOR CONSIDERING RECLASSIFICATIO PRINTING INDUSTRY FROM LT II B TO LT III-A1

Preliminary

Telengana Offset Printers Association (for short TOPA), objector herein, is Society registered under Telengana Societies Registration Act -2001, established in the year 2013 to represent the interest of offset printers in the state of Telangana, most respectfully submit as under

1. Printing presses were considered as an industrial activity and the Electricity

Tariff was Industrial Tariff under category LT III-A1 till the year 2011-2012.

However, in the year 2012, EPCPDCL, in its ERC & ARR petition in O.P No: 02 of

2011, proposed category change from prevailing LT III (A)1 to LTII(B). The same

was approved in the tariff order Dated: 30-03-2011 to be made applicable from

2012-2013. The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:

149. The issue of classification of News paper printing & printing presses has been brought to the notice of the Commission by CPDCL and it stated that News paper printing units shall be classified under HT-I Industry and all other printing activities shall come under HT-II Others. Similar treatment shall be extended to LT consumers also i.e., News paper printing in LT-III Industrial & other printing activities in LT – II Non Domestic/Commercial.

Commission's view:

The Commission accepted the proposal of CPDCL and included the News paper printing units in HT-I Industry and LT-III Industrial as the case may be. All other printing activities shall come under HT-II others or LT-II Non Domestic / Commercial as the case may be.

2. The reason for the request for seeking reclassification is not known to us. In our humble opinion the Licensee should have brought the subject matter before the commission as a separate application, making the general public as a party since the category change would cause a tariff shock. More so equating small printers to fall in line with News paper industry is mistake, since they are not comparable both in terms of volume and financial capabilities. Whereas News paper business is a large scale activity with huge investment, small scale printing activity is a manufacturing activity, which largely depends upon others like Publishers of Books and requirements of general public. The said activity can never be compared with News paper publishing business.

Admittedly this analysis of the activities of both the News paper industry and small scale printing industry has not happened and a fair opportunity for the affected parties has not been afforded. We earnestly believe that the Hon'ble Commission should have passed an order after affording an opportunity to the persons likely to be affected the change in category.

- Printing Industry is a small scale service activity both under the earlier definition of SSI and now under MSMED Act- 2006
 - 3. It is submitted that the printing industry was recognized as a Small Scale Industry (SSI) as per Circular No. 2(3)91-SSI Board Dt.30th September 1991(Annexure -1). Further, by another Notification bearing No. 2(3)/91-SSI Board Dt. 3rd January'1992, (Annexure-2) it was clarified that printing press was eligible to registered as Small Scale industry (SSI). Reproduced below are extracts from MSMED Act 2006

Definitions of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises In accordance with the provision of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act, 2006 the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) are classified in two Classes:

1.Manufacturing Enterprises- The enterprises engaged in the manufacture or production of goods pertaining to any industry specified in the first schedule to the industries (Development and regulation) Act, 1951) or employing plant and machinery in the process of value addition to the final product having a distinct

name or character or use. The Manufacturing Enterprise is defined in terms of investment in Plant & Machinery.

2. Service Enterprises:-The enterprises engaged in providing or rendering of services and are **defined in terms of investment in equipment**.

The limit for investment in plant and machinery / equipment for manufacturing / service enterprises, as notified, vide S.O. 1642(E) dtd.29-09-2006 are as under

4. Also, Under circular issued by Additional Development Commissioner D.O. No.2(3)11/2007- MSME POL (Annexure -3) vide Para V read with Para VI the printing activities came to be Registrable as SSSBE's wherein the eligibility for

treatment on par with industrial activity was not altered. A Copy of the Notification is produced and marked as Annexure - 4

5. In the above scenario, we wish to state as under:

a) With the change in tariff LT III A (1) category to II (B) the electricity charges have enormously increased to the extent of giving Tariff shock and as a consequence running a printing industry has become unviable since the whole process involves the several intermediary steps which has electricity cost as an input cost.

Compared to our neighboring states, printing business has become uncompetitive on account of increased electricity Tariff. The several stages involved in the printing process are outlined here under

I) Pre-press.

- a) DTP. b) Designing. c) Page making. d) Preparation of computer plate.
- 2). Press.
- a) Printing
- 3) Post Press

- (a) Lamination (b) Pinning (c) Punching (d) Coating (e) Foiling (f) Embossing
- (g) Case Binding / Spiral Binding (h) Varnishing. (g) Trimming

In each of the above processes the cost of energy, as an input cost, would have a cascading effect on the total cost of production. Also many of the processes are out sourced due to lack of all facilities available under one roof, will add to the total cost in terms of costs involved in transportation of materials at every stage.

- 6. Compared to our neighboring states, printing business in Telengana has become un-competitive. In today's scenario, our industries have to compete and cater the needs of industry and trade across India and also nowadays, sourcing from countries like Hong Kong and Singapore has become very common.
- 7. As a consequence, printing business in our state has dwindled and several printing presses have closed down and many are struggling for survival. In our neighboring States like Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu the tariffs for the printing industry is Industrial Tariff. Enclosed are the Tariff schedules of these states. Needless to say our printing orders from Middle East countries have virtually dried up.

- 8. Additionally, the unexpected consequences of the abnormal tariff, the employment opportunities, Revenue from VAT and other Taxes would also progressively reduce causing hard ships not only to the society but also to the Government. In this back drop it becomes all the more important to take a holistic view and correct the anomaly.
- 9. In this context, a comparative Tariff for LT industry and LT commercial Tariff in our State of Telangana for the year 2015-16 reproduced for quick reference

As can be seen from the above the present tariff from printing press above 500 unit consumption is almost 50% higher than the LT industrial Tariff. (Emphasis and under line supplied)

10. The objectors also wishes to place before the commission a comparative statement showing tariffs for SSI / MSMED under LT Industry category across the country, appended to this representation marked as Annexure - 5

For the foregoing reason the objector prays for the following.

SMALL, TINY AND INDUSTRY RELATED SERVICE/BUSINESS ENTERPRISES

Sir,

Kindly refer to last para of this office letter of even No.dated 16th August 1991 in which it was stated that registration of SSSBE's may await receipt of instructions and that an illustrative list of SSSBE will follow.

- II.Prior to the issue of this letter, guidelines were issued by the Department of Industrial Development vide their letter No.SSI(I)-12 (14)/82 dated 18th May 1982 to register all service oriented enterprises as small scale service Establishment (SSSE) in which some minimum investment in fixed assets in plant and machinery upto Rs.2 lakhs was involved and the same were located in rural areas and towns with a population upto 5 lakhs.
- III.At different points of time, certain clarifications were issued by this office whether an activity was registered as SSI, SSSE or none of these. The entire list needs to be reviewed as some of these items/activities do not really qualify as industrial activities to be covered under SIDO, while some others are also not manufacturing activities but only service activities. In the latter category, not all service activities will qualify as industry related service activities. As per the new policy on small eligible scale industries, not all small service establishments will henceforth be for benefits/concessions available to units in Small Scale Sector. Only such of those small enterprises whether service or business which are industry related (now named as SSSBE's) will be eligible for benefits/concessions admissible to Small Scale Sector. It has, therefore, been decided to re-classify various activities into Small Scale Industry (SSI) and Small Scale (Industry related) Service Business Enterprise (SSSBE).

IV.SMALL SCALE INDUSTRY

- 1.It will cover the manufacturing activities of one or more item(s) included
 - a.Schedule I of Industries (Development & Regulation) Act, 1951 (65 of 1951).
 - b. The list of items exclusively reserved for manufacture in the Small Scale Sector.
 - c. Any manufacturing activity which is not covered above in (a) or

EXCEPT

The activities which fall within the purview of any Statutory Board or Committee or Special Agency viz. KVIC, Silk Board, Handicrafts Board, Textile Commissioner, Handloom Board, Coir Board etc.

2. The following activities had been recognised as SSI, falling within the purview of MSME-DO, through clarifications issued by this office from time to time.

i. Biochemical/Biological testing laboratories.

ii. Hatcheries.

iii. Tissue culture.

iv. Beedi making/Tobacco processing.

v. Colour Film processing studios.

vi. Laboratories engaged in testing of raw materials and finished products.

vii. Software servicing and data processing.

viii. Documentary film production units.

ix. Servicing industry undertakings engaged in maintenance, repair, testing or servicing of all types of vehicles and machinery of any description including electronic / electrical equipment / instruments i.e., measuring/control instruments, televisions, tape recorders, VCR's, radios, transformers, motors etc.

x. Printing press.

It has now been decided that none of the activities above will be recognised as SSI. The activities (vi) to (x) will however be registrable as SSSBE's (See para VI below). The remaining activities i.e. (i) to (v) above will not be recognised even as SSSBE's.

TINY ENTERPRISES

Guidelines issued vide above referred letter dated 16.8.1991 are self-explanatory and the same be followed.

SMALL SCALE SERVICE & BUSINESS (INDUSTRY RELATED) ENTERPRISES (SSSBE's)

The following guidelines shall be followed for the registration of SSSBE's.

As a follow up, action to Policy Measures for promoting and strengthening small, Tiny and village Enterprises, announced on 6th August, 1991 Government have decided to give benefits of small scale sector to all Industry related service and Business Enterprises with investment upto Rs.5 lakhs in fixed assets, excluding land and building. For computation of value of fixed assets the original price paid by the original owner will be considered irrespective of the price paid by subsequent owners.

Instructions issued vide Ministry's circular letter no. SSI(I)-12(14)/82 dated 18 May 1982 giving benefits to all small scale service Establishments (SSSEs) having fixed investment in plant and machinery upto Rs.2 lakhs etc., STAND SUPERCEDED. Now onwards, only industry related small scale service/Business Enterprises (SSSBE's) upto Rs.5 lakhs, as in (1) above will be eligible for benefits and concessions available to

industries in small scale sector.

An illustrative list of SSSBE's and the illustrative list of activities that will not qualify as SSSBE (i.e. small scale service and Business (Industry related) Enterprises) is given at Annexure I and Annexure II respectively.

Activities like hatchery, poultry farm, hair cutting salloons, beauty parlous etc. which were earlier declared as SSSE activity will no longer be registrable as SSI or SSSBE.

The activities like Hotels (including unstarred hotels, tea cafeteria and restaurants), small service medical establishment, small rural medical service establishment, broiler scheme, decorator (both pandal and lighting), aturopathic institutions, nature cure hospitals, dental clinics, slate quarries (mining process), Piggery, fishery, cattle rearig, rabbit farming butchery, meat selling, slimming centres, dairy (if only selling milk), hot mix plant were referred to this office in the past to ascertain whether these qualify to be registered as SSSE's? It is now clarified that none of these activities is registrable as SSSBE as the same are not recognised as industry ralated service business activities.

The units which have been registered as SSI or SSSE prior to issue of these instructions, as per instructions prevailing then and which are not so registrable now, shall continue to get assistance as per existing registration. These cases need not be reopened for deregistration. Existing units, registered as SSSE will get benefits of small scale until their investment exceeds Rs.5 lakhs.

In continuation to this office letters of even number referred to above, this is to inform you that it has been decided to recognise the following activities as Small Scale (Industry Related) Service/Business Enterprises i.e. SSSBE:-

- A. Sub-contracting Exchanges (SEXs) established by Non-Government Industry Associations and
- B. EDP Institute established by Voluntary Associations/Non-Government Organisations.

These will be eligible to get the registration with Directorate of Industries in the category of SSSBE and will be entitled to avail benefits available to small scale industries until their investment in fixed assets, excluding land and building, exceed Rs.5 lakhs.

Likewise it was declared vide letter dated 30.9.1991 referred to above that Software Servicing & Data Processing and Printing presses can be registered as SSSBE's. These items have been referred to in Para IV (2) (vii) and (x) respectively of the said letter,

This issue has been reviewed/reconsidered and it has been decided to recognise the said activities viz. Software Servicing & Data Processing (including computer graphics) and Printing press as industrial activity registerable as Small Scale Industry (SSI) and this office letter dated 30.9.1991 referred to above stands amended accordingly.

Section 7(1)(b) of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, which has come into force with effect from 2 October 2006, clarifies service enterprises as micro, small or medium based on the investment in the "Equipments" and section 8(1)(a) &(b) of the Act provides for filing of Entrepreneurs Memorandum (EM) by such enterprises.

- 2. Under the erstwhile policy of SSI registration, an illustrative list of service activities (industry related), which could be registered as SSSBEs were circulated by this office for the reference of the registering authorities. However, with the implementation of the MSMED Act 2006, we have received a number of references from State Governments requesting for clarification regarding filing of EM for the service activities by the enterprises and also for providing a list of service activities so that the EM for those can be acknowledged under the MSMED Act 2006.
- 3. An illustrative list of activities classified as service activities by WTO/GATT, which can be acknowledged as service enterprises under the MSMED Act, 2006, is enclosed for reference to avoid delays in the acknowledgement of the EMs for service enterprises. However, it is emphasized that it is only an illustrative list and that there is no negative list of services that are not to be acknowledged
